



Resuming Dubai's Economic Activities From Wednesday, May 27, 2020 from 6 a.m. to 11 p.m.

- Retail and wholesale
- Airport, operating for returning UAE residents and transit passengers after authorities approval
- Clinics, including ENT and dentistry, and expanding permitted elective surgeries to those with duration of 2.5 hours or less
- Educational and training institutes, and child learning and therapy centers
- Sports academies, indoor gyms, sports and fitness clubs
- Cinemas, with continued social distancing and regular disinfection in place
- Entertainment and leisure attractions, such as Dubai Ice Rink, Dolphinarium, etc
- Auctions, with online auctions preferred over physical when possible
- Outsourced government service centers





General Rules

- Activities authorised to operate must abide by the timings of the national sterilisation programme.
- Social distance of 2 metres must be maintained by all.
- All those returning from abroad must adhere to a 14-day quarantine.
- Masks are obligatory and must be worn at all times.
- Sterilisation must continuously be carried out and only single-use utensils allowed.
- Violators of rules and guidelines will be fined, according to the type of violation.
- Children under 12, elderly over 60 and those with chronic diseases and prone to infection, are not allowed to enter malls, cinemas, sports facilities and educational institutes.
